## LESTARI Introducing the New Library Catalogue

**LESTARI** is the acronym for Library Electronic System and Research Information, a new online library catalogue for Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah. The catalogue allows you to perform faceted and federated search with just a single click.

### What is faceted and federated search?

Faceted search is increasingly being adopted by most online library catalogue in the world. It allows you to refine your search results, by continually narrowing it until you get your desired items. Meanwhile, federated search allows you to search multiple databases simultaneously. This simply means you do not have to switch to different interface to search for printed materials within the library and electronic materials from online databases. You can do both from a single search page. See how easy information retrieval have become!



### What other benefits can I get by using LESTARI?

In addition, the new catalogue allows you to check your Library account online using My Library Account. Among its features are:

- Renew materials.
- View fines.
- View, edit or cancel holds.
- Review and edit your library account at your own ease.

Majlis pelancaran UTM Reading Stations (UTMRS) oleh Menteri Penerangan Komunikasi dan Kebudayaan, Dato' Seri Utama Dr. Rais Yatim telah disempurnakan di Dewan Jamuan, Bangunan Canseleri Sultan Ibrahim pada 1 Julai 2010.

Pembangunan UTMRS adalah bagi menyokong menzahirkan ekosistem intelektual di kalangan masyarakat kampus dan sekitarnya dengan penyediaan bahan bacaan untuk dikongsi bersama. Ditubuhkan pada 4 Mei 2009, UTMRS bermula dengan 16 lokasi di seluruh UTM dan pada 2 Julai 2009 jumlah ini telah meningkat kepada 45 UTMRS. Sehingga April 2010, terdapat 48 UTMRS di UTM Johor Baharu dan 10 buah di UTM International Campus, Kuala Lumpur, menjadikan sebanyak 58 UTMRS di pelbagai lokasi tumpuan masyarakat UTM.



Apa yang menarik bagi koleksi UTMRS adalah ia dibangunkan melalui sumbangan secara sukarela oleh warga UTM. Langkah ini secara tidak langsung memupuk semangat bahawa UTMRS adalah milik bersama warga kampus. Kotak-kotak khas untuk menyumbang koleksi buku serta majalah disediakan di Fakulti, Jabatan, Pusat Kecemerlangan, Kolej Mahasiswa serta di beberapa lokasi strategik di sekitar kampus. Sehingga kini koleksi UTMRS berjumlah 11,419 naskhah.

## Searching Using LESTARI the New Library Catalogue.

### Getting Started with Quick Search

To start, visit the Library web site at <http://www.utm.my/psz> and click on the Library Catalogue link. Typically, the first search page that you access has simple Quick Search options.



1. To begin a search, type a term in the search box.
2. You can select either the **Search All** or **Search Resource** radio button, with the following actions.
  - ✓ Selecting **Search All** activates in all the possible search areas offered by the library.
  - ✓ Selecting **Search Resource** activates a drop-down list, from which you can choose to direct your search to the type of collection in the library's catalogue, to other libraries or to the subscribed online databases.
3. Select a library to search in the **Limit OPAC By** box, or select **ALL** to include all branches in the search.
4. Select a **Match On** option to match a search term on the Exact, Keyword, or Partial term qualifiers.
5. Click **Search** to begin the search.

### Advanced Catalogue Search

You can begin an advanced catalogue search by selecting **Advanced Catalogue Search** wherever it is available. Use this option to **combine search elements** or **refine or limit a search**.

#### 1. Combining Search Elements

You can combine **Search Index Elements** such as word or phrase, author, title, subject, series, periodical title, or other searches configured by the library. Use the drop-down list arrows to select other available search options.

- ✓ Type a **General** word or phrase for a typical search.
- ✓ Type an **Author** to search for the name.
- ✓ Type a **Title** to search for an item by title.
- ✓ Type a **Subject** to search the subject index.
- ✓ Type a **Series** to search for a series title.
- ✓ Type a **Periodical Title** to search the periodical keyword index.

#### 2. Narrowing The Search

Use Advanced Catalogue Search to narrow your search based on criteria configured by the library.

- ✓ Select a **Library** to limit your search to a specific branch, or select ALL to search in all branches.
- ✓ Select **Item Group** to limit your search to Books, Journals, Maps & Charts, UTM Thesis Collections or other collections.
- ✓ In the **Pub Year** box, type the year the item was published, if known.
- ✓ You can sort your search results by selecting criteria in the **Sort Results By** box. Options might include sorting by author, title, subject or publication year.

Once you have limited the search, click **Search** to start your search.

### Browse Searching

You can switch to browsing from **Advanced Catalogue Search** by clicking Browse Search located at the left side of your screen.

Combine search index elements using **Boolean operators** such as AND, OR and NOT. Then click **Search** to start your search.

1. In the **Browse On** box, type in the search term.
2. In **Library** box, select the library branch to search under, or select ALL to search all branches.
3. Select the appropriate options to complete your browse search.

For example:

- Author
- Title
- Subject
- Series
- Periodical

## For the Researchers: Simple Tips For Publishing Your Academic Journal Article.

### 1. Choose the right journal.

"The first step towards writing for scholarly journals is to acquire the habit of reading them." - Meaghan Morris (1998)

Make sure the subject area of your article matched the journal scope. Do not attempt to publish your article in a journal that does not cater to your topic. Read the journal regularly to familiarise yourself with its concepts and standards - and make sure your article fits that standard.

Once you have made your choice, remember to cite several articles from the journal. Want to go extra mile? Check the editorial board, and cite some of their work too! You will score some brownie points as many of those peers review and evaluate your article.

### 2. Be unique. Be novel.

Provide a clear statement of novelty - find a unique angle of your research article. You would not want to present any ideas which have already been published. Be specific. Be focused. Determine clearly what are the possible implications or applications from the study.

### 3. Perform a thorough literature review.

According to Randolph (2009), literature review demonstrates an author's knowledge about the field of study - vocabulary, theories, key variables and phenomena. Through literature review, you would be able to:

- Distinguish what has been done from what needs to be done.
- Rationalising the significance of your research problem.
- Exhibit advance existing knowledge of your research.

Most importantly, literature review will provide you with a framework to relate new findings to previous findings - which is crucial in the discussion section of your research.

### 4. Write clearly.

"There is no substitute for a good idea, for excellent research or for good, clean, clear writing." - Nora S. Newcombe, former editor of APA's *Journal of Experimental Psychology: General*

Keep the language simple and in short sentences. Most importantly, edit your work. All it takes is a few typos, missing words, or grammatical errors for the reader to form an opinion of you as "careless."

Therefore, find someone to edit your paper. Every writer makes mistakes, so make sure that someone else catches those before submitting your article.

### 5. Proofread and pre-review before submission.

Do not forget to check for submission guidelines. Try to adhere to the stated length requirements and be sure that your citation style is flawless.

Review your article with a fresh eye. Two pairs of fresh eyes, preferred. Recruit two objective colleagues - one who is familiar with your topic whom can provide technical advice, while another who knows little or nothing about it whom can determine whether your ideas are being communicated clearly (Hewlett, 2002).

# Moving from Printed Journals to E-journals

Starting 2010, about 166 journal titles has moved from printed format to electronic format. Unlike most of the e-journals which could be accessed via online databases such as ScienceDirect, SpringerLink etc, these journals are available directly from its' publisher's websites. Follow these simple steps to get access to the journals.



3. A list of subscribed e-journal titles would appear. You can browse or use the title filter to search for a particular journal. Click on the title to view the journal.



## **FAQ: Interlibrary Loan Service**

### **What is Interlibrary Loan (ILL)?**

At PSZ, ILL is a service whereby we act on behalf of the library users to borrow books or receive photocopies of documents that are owned by another library. Before using this service, users are advised to check our collection thoroughly to ensure what is needed is definitely not available from PSZ.

### **How?**

The user makes a request with PSZ, which, acting as an intermediary, identifies owners of the desired item, places the request, receives the item, makes it available to the user, and arranges for its return. A processing fee of RM2.00 is required for this service.

### **Who can use this service?**

This service is provided to all registered members, in connection with their academic and teaching purposes, except External Membership.

### **Where can I make my request?**

1. Fill up the Interlibrary Loan form available from the Research Support Consultant, or
2. Apply online via LESTARI (to be available soon).

### **What type of materials is available through Interlibrary Loan?**

- Book (monographs, pamphlets etc.)
- Journal/Article (periodicals, serials, newspapers etc.)
- Conference (proceedings and papers)
- Report (reports, patents and standard)

### **How long does it take to get the items requested?**

The average is 1 month. This time can be much shorter (especially for articles/photocopies), but it can also be longer, depending upon the location of the lending library, how fast the lending library responded and the also the efficiency of the postal service.

### **How many items may I request?**

You can request up to 5 items at a time.

### **How do I know if an item is available?**

You will receive an email from our Interlibrary Loan librarian.

### **Where do I pick up my books?**

All requested items should be collected from Circulation Counter.

### **How soon do I need to pick up my books?**

Items need to be picked up within a week or before the due date given. Items that are not picked up will be returned to the lending library.

### **How long can I keep Interlibrary Loan items?**

You may keep an Interlibrary Loan book for two weeks.

### **Can I renew my Interlibrary Loan item?**

It depends on the lending library. Email us at [ill@mel.psz.utm.my](mailto:ill@mel.psz.utm.my) to renew the book few days before the due date. However, in case the lending library refuses to extend the borrowing, user must return the book on the given due date.

# Perkongsian Ilmu melalui K-Sharing @ PSZ

PSZ telah menganjurkan program perkongsian ilmu dan pengetahuan iaitu K-Sharing pada 6 Ogos 2010 dengan membawa topik berkaitan kecergasan dan kesihatan.

Bersempena bulan Ramadan yang lepas, ceramah bertajuk "Aktiviti Fizikal untuk Kecergasan dan Kesihatan" dilihat amat bersesuaian untuk para hadirin mendapatkan tips untuk kekal cergas walaupun dalam keadaan berpuasa. Penceramah pada hari itu adalah Puan Aqilah Leela T. Narayanan, pensyarah Fakulti Kejuruteraan Bioperubatan dan Sains Kesihatan (FKBSK) yang mempunyai kepakaran dalam bidang fisioterapi dan rehabilitasi. Program tersebut telah dibahagikan kepada dua sesi iaitu sesi ceramah dan sesi praktikal latihan fizikal. Melalui sesi praktikal, para hadirin telah turut serta melakukan senaman ringan dengan cara yang betul dan berkesan. Moderator program ialah En. Kassim Thukiman, Pensyarah Kanan dari Fakulti Pengurusan & Pembangunan Sumber Manusia (FPPSM) yang juga seorang pengkaji sejarah serta aktif dalam kegiatan penulisan sejarah khususnya sejarah Malaysia.



Program turut dimuatkan dengan persembahan slaid "Tragedi Natrah dalam Sejarah" dan juga pameran yang dibawakan khas oleh DBP berjudul "Korban kasih Dua Benua". Selain itu Penerbit UTM Press turut mengadakan jualan buku "Natrah: Cinta, Rusuhan, Air mata" hasil karya Datin Seri Fatini Yaacob yang merakamkan kisah hidup Natrah hingga ke akhir hayatnya.

## UTM Institutional Repository (UTM-IR) Remains in the Top Spot

Universiti Teknologi Malaysia  
Institutional Repository



UTM Institutional Repository (UTM-IR) acts as a portal to allow storing and retrieval of academic works that includes online electronic journals, theses and research findings written and published by UTM's academic staff, researchers and students. Since its introduction in 2007, UTM-IR has achieved many firsts including the first learning institution from Malaysia to be listed in Registry of Open Access Repository or ROAR (<http://roar.eprints.org>). UTM-IR is also the one and only Institutional Repository from Malaysia in the top 100 institutional listed in the Ranking Web of World Repositories.

As of July 2010, UTM-IR is ranked 91st from the top 400 Repositories and 77th from the top 400 Institutional Repositories (IR) in the world. UTM-IR has also maintained as the only IR from Malaysia to be listed in the top 100. Through UTM-IR, the University has provided the community with the most current and systematic collection of publication works, and has successfully performed its role in generating and disseminating knowledge to the society.
