
PSZ Welcomes New Students!

Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah is a valuable partner in our users' pursuit towards excellence in learning and research. Our value lies in the valuable information resources, tools, services and facilities that we provide to all UTM staff and students. We have a range of library materials that cater to various learning needs and preferences. Our print collection stands at more than half a million books now and is growing each year. Both undergraduates and postgraduates students can borrow up to 10 and 15 books respectively at any one time. Search the library catalogue or INFOLAN2 to find the books that you want.

Our rich electronic resources comprise about 75 subscribed online databases covering all disciplines and 200,000 e-journal titles, nearly 30,000 e-books titles and more than a million e-theses. These e-resources can be accessed from anywhere - in dormitories, at your home and even when you are in another country. All you need is Internet access, an ACID account and your password. We also make available the full-text of UTM research articles and theses in our UTM Institutional Repository as well as online examination papers.



EndNote X3 Bibliographic Management Tool is Now Available

Researchers often find it a major chore to store references and notes on the literature they read and use. EndNote is a bibliographic software programme which allows you to create your own list of bibliographic references. The primary function of EndNote is to provide a medium for systematic and accessible storage of bibliographic data, but it has other uses, such as inserting in-text citations into your articles, conference papers or thesis, formatting correctly in the style of the publication for which you are writing, and compiling and formatting a matching bibliography. It can also be used to connect to selected library catalogues and online databases and to download references.

In short, Endnote allows you to

- Stores and organizes citations found from many sources.
- Inserts these citations into a Word document with the click of a button.
- Automatically formats the references according to a predefined citation style.






The Library Code of Conduct

The Library wants users to get the maximum benefit from using our services and seeks to provide an enjoyable and pleasant environment in which to do so: friendly, safe, secure and relaxed.



This code of conduct is a general statement covering the expected behaviour of users of the Library.

- ➔ Display your UTM ID card at all times - this is a University requirement.
- ➔ Return books, journals and all other items used in the Library to the correct place.
- ➔ Treat the Library staff and other users with respect and courtesy.
- ➔ Silence must be observed in the silent study area - Level 2, 4 and 5.
- ➔ Using mobile phones to make or receive calls is permitted in the designated zone located at the main stairwells.
- ➔ Eating and drinking (except for plain drinking water) is prohibited in all areas.
- ➔ Be prepared to pay any fines or charges incurred. Failure to pay outstanding charges may result in withdrawal of services or the withholding of your transcript.



How to Search for a Book in the Library?

Learn how to do a simple search using **INFOLAN2 - PSZ Online Public Access Catalogue**.

- Go to the library catalogue (INFOLAN2) from our website (<http://www.psz.utm.my/psz>) and click on Books.
- From the right panel, choose **Keyword Search** if you are unsure of the complete title or the author of the book. Browse Searching can be used to browse the exact title of the book or author's name. Click **Submit Search**.
- A **Result List** will be displayed. Click on the title that you wish to view.
- A bibliographic record for the book will appear. The call number and the location indicate at which level and shelf the book is located.




For the Researchers: Advantages of Using **EndNote X3**

EndNote allows you to store detailed information on your references. You can record bibliographic information such as the author(s), year and date of publication, title, name of publication, volume, issue and page numbers. But you can also use EndNote to store abstracts, annotations about articles, information on where the journal is kept, or cross references to other articles on a similar topic. You can even use the notes section in EndNote to write the material you will later incorporate into your literature review.

EndNote can also make it easier to locate your information. If you compile an EndNote database which contains information about hundreds or thousands of references, you can use it to locate and display all the articles by a given author and your notes on each of them. It also allows you to locate, in a matter of seconds, all the references with a given keyword in the data or within your notes or your abstracts. It can be used to import data files saved from a variety of online database services or CD ROMs.



Moving between EndNote and your writing is easy. EndNote has been designed to run in conjunction with Microsoft Word or WordPerfect and it becomes a plug-in tool which is located through a tool bar. Inserting an in-text citation involves just a few mouse clicks to locate and select the desired reference in your EndNote data file (called a 'library') and then you can switch back to your manuscript.

EndNote recognises that you will have to deal with a variety of resource types and that each of these has different kinds of data. EndNote gives you a list of reference types which include journal article, book, book section, edited book, newspaper article, personal communication, computer program, conference paper, thesis, map, report, audio visual material, electronic source, patent, artwork and a type labelled generic. This helps to identify and group your sources as primary, secondary or tertiary.

Most importantly EndNote allows you to change the format of your bibliography to suit the style of different publications. EndNote is preconfigured for most commonly recognised reference styles; these may be modified to suit your own needs, and unwanted fields may be deleted.


eBooks : The Latest Fad?

Ebooks are the latest way to publish anything, and the term "e-book" simply means "electronic book." An ebook is a type of computer file, but it is more complex than a document in a word processing program. It is downloaded from the Internet into your computer so you can read it on the screen of an electronic device. An ebook has pages, illustrations, and chapters like a real book. All kinds of books can be made into ebooks, from reference manuals to our textbooks.

Ebooks come in various formats, namely :

- ⇒ HTML stands for HyperText Markup Language, and this format can be read on most computers.
- ⇒ PDF means Portable Document Format, and it looks a lot like printed pages on your computer screen.

In order to fulfill the growing demands for books from our users, the Library is currently subscribing a number of eBook databases. So, next time if you could not find it on the shelves, it might be in any of these databases!



Program Bicara Karya siri ketiga telah berlangsung pada 23 April 2010 bertempat di Bilik Seminar 3 PSZ. Buku berjudul "Pendita Za'ba Dalam Kenangan" hasil karya Abdullah Hussain dan Khalid M. Hussain telah dibicarakan oleh Puan Junainah Jukee yang merupakan staf PSZ. 31st Annual International Association of Scientific and Technological University Libraries (IATUL) Conference - The Evolving World of e-Science: Impact and Implications for Science and Technology Libraries, Purdue University, USA - 20 - 24 June 2010.

The Chief Librarian, Puan Kamariah Nor Mohd. Desa and the Head of Automation Division, Puan Nor Asikin Mohamad, attended the 31st Annual International Association of Scientific and Technological University Libraries (IATUL) Conference - The Evolving World of e-Science: Impact and Implications for Science and Technology Libraries which was held on 20 - 24 June 2010.

The main objective of the conference was to provide a forum for the exchange of ideas relevant to librarianship in technological universities throughout the world. The discussions were focused on the current state of e-science and how libraries and information professionals are contributing to the creation, visualisation, interoperability and usability of research data and knowledge bases.

Prior to that, both of them also took the opportunity to visit several libraries located at Purdue University, West Lafayette, Indiana, USA which include J.W. Hicks Undergraduate Library, Humanities, Social Sciences and Education Library - Steward Center, Siegesmund Engineering Library - A. A Potter Engineering Center, Physics Library - Physics Building, Management and Economics Library - Krannert Building and Earth and Atmospheric Sciences Library - Civil Engineering Building. Most of the collections available in the library were centred on the subject and courses being offered by the faculties. There was also a visit to Science and Technology Museum in Chicago which showcased the numerous phenomena in both fields with the use of advanced technology.

Throughout the visits, participants were exposed to the library management being practiced by Purdue University as well as up to date information relevant to the field of science and technology.
