Perpustakaan UTM Anjur Bengkel Petunjuk Prestasi Bagi Perpustakaan Akademik di Malaysia

Petunjuk Prestasi Utama atau ringkasnya Key Performance Indicator (KPI) akan menjadi teras utama kepada ketelusan pentadbiran sesebuah perpustakaan akademik untuk masa depan. Menyedari hal ini, Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia telah mengadakan Bengkel Petunjuk Prestasi (KPI) untuk Perpustakaan Akademik pada 27 hingga 28 Jun 2011 bertempat di Hotel Maya, Kuala Lumpur. Selaku perpustakaan di Institut Pengajian Tinggi Awam, KPI merupakan suatu 'benchmark' yang mampu melonjak prestasi universiti untuk menyediakan perkhidmatan dan kemudahan yang mantap serta menghasilkan perpustakaan yang berdaya saing di masa hadapan. KPI bukanlah suatu terma baharu, oleh yang demikian, usaha mengadakan bengkel seumpama ini merupakan pendekatan yang mampu merealisasikan hasrat berkenaan.



Objektif bengkel ini adalah untuk menyediakan set performance indicators yang seragam, menjadi landasan kepada analisis setiap perkhidmatan dan kemudahan serta memperlihatkan kemajuan dan pembangunan sesebuah perpustakaan. Selain itu, bengkel ini diharap dapat menjadi kaedah penandaan (benchmark) di kalangan perpustakaan akademik di Malaysia.

Sesi dan aktiviti semasa bengkel selama 2 hari itu telah dikendalikan oleh En. Anuar Talib selaku Timbalan Ketua Pustakawan (Perancangan & Pembangunan) dan Pn. Noraziah Sharuddin selaku Timbalan Ketua Pustakawan (Perkhidmatan). Peserta bengkel terdiri dari pelbagai kategori pustakawan dari perpustakaan akademik di seluruh Malaysia dan lima buah perpustakaan swasta yang terdiri dari MMU, OUM, UniKL, UTP dan UNITEN. Seramai 40 orang telah menyertai bengkel yang pertama kali diadakan ini.

Facilitator telah digalakkan untuk memberi keterangan atau 'significance' mengenai petunjuk prestasi yang disediakan. Semua peserta yang mengikuti bengkel ini dapat memberi interpretasi yang jelas mengenai KPI masing-masing dan kaedah pelaksanaannya yang sistematik dan mudah untuk dipatuhi. Pada penghujung sesi, satu revolusi (kata sepakat) mengenai petunjuk prestasi seragam telah dapat dihasilkan. Mengakhiri bengkel, peserta berharap KPI yang telah dibentuk ini dapat dipraktikkan yang menjurus kepada peningkatan kualiti kerja seterusnya perjalanan bengkel ini dapat dimaklumkan kepada pihak PERPUN untuk tindakan selanjutnya.

Meanwhile, for the researchers, do check out page 4 and 5 for the latest databases and research tools for your use. So, have your ACID/ISID username and password ready and get started!



Summary :

In his twenty-two years as Prime Minister of Malaysia Dr Mahathir Mohamad transformed his country from an agricultural backwater into an industrial powerhouse that would become the seventeenth-largest trading nation in the world.

This remarkable achievement was not without controversy, and Dr Mahathir's extraordinary vision and iron grip earned him both enemies as well as ardent admirers within and outside of Malaysia. He has been described—typically and paradoxically—as a tyrannical dictator, a bête noir, as well as inspiring, courageous and an outspoken defender of the downtrodden, the Third World, and moderate Islam.

At almost every turn Dr Mahathir rewrote the rules. This book reveals hitherto unknown aspects of this intensely private, but publicly bold, statesman. It provides a clear and compelling narrative of modern Malaysian political history as seen through the eyes of one its greatest shapers. It is neither apology nor defense, but a forceful, compelling and often exciting account of how Dr Mahathir achieved what he did in so short a time, and why.

Library Guide for New Students

Here is the basic guide on the Library which should help you to get started.

1. Activate your membership - Every student is issued with a UTM Identification card when they first register with the University. To activate your membership, come to the Library and bring along the card. The barcode, affixed on the reverse of the card, is used to activate the membership. This will be your username which you can use to access My Library Account or the online databases and also to check out books. Meanwhile your password or PIN is a 6 digit number which you selected upon the
2. Inside the Library – Always wear your UTM ID card prominently upon entering the Library. Put your hand phone on silent mode so as not to disturb other users. You may use your hand phone at designated areas only. Be properly attired as required by the University's dress code.
3. Using the Library – Head to Level 2 for our collection of printed theses and current or backdated printed journals. Surf and search for information using our computer facilities located at Level 3. Bringing your own laptop? You can have access to the Internet at our designated Laptop Area or anywhere throughout the Library via UTMWIFI. Our vast collection of textbooks and reference books are located at Level 4 and Level 5.
4. Searching for book – is much easier with LESTARI – the online public access catalogue (OPAC) which can be accessed from anywhere. Log in to <http://www.utm.my/psz> to find out more.
5. Borrowing and returning – can be done in two ways, the traditional over the counter or the convenient, brightly coloured self check machines. Do not forget your receipt – you will need that to remind you on your due date. However, you can also use My Library Account via LESTARI to check your current loans, due dates and accumulated fines.



Persidangan Inisiatif Akses Terbuka Poland Beri Idea Pemantapan Organisasi PSZ

Ketua Pustakawan Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah, UTM iaitu Pn. Kamariah Nor Mohd Desa bersama En. Anuar Talib selaku Timbalan Ketua Pustakawan (Perancangan & Pembangunan) telah menyertai 32nd Annual IATUL Conference di Warsaw, Poland pada 29 Mei hingga 2 Jun 2011. Persidangan International Association of Scientific and Technological University Libraries (IATUL) ini telah berlangsung di Warsaw University of Technology dan ia adalah aktiviti tahunan dan kali ini ia bertemakan "Libraries for an Open Environment: Strategies, Technologies and Partnerships".

Persidangan tersebut telah memfokuskan kepada beberapa intipati penting seperti Open Scholarly Communication, Open Access, Blended Learning and E-learning, Open Resources for Higher Education, Repositories and Digital Libraries dan Improving Librarian Skills. Beberapa kertas kerja telah menyentuh mengenai perkembangan inisiatif akses terbuka (institutional repository) di Australia, Poland dan beberapa Negara Blok Eropah Timur telah dilaksanakan di peringkat kebangsaan. Sebaliknya di Malaysia, pelaksanaannya masih di peringkat institusi di mana UTM telah muncul sebagai universiti pelopor kepada inisiatif akses terbuka bagi bahan ilmiahnya dan tersenarai dalam Registry of Open Access Repositories (ROAR). Kini, inisiatif akses terbuka ini telah banyak dibangunkan oleh perpustakaan akademik di Malaysia sebagai medan merancang perkongsian ilmu di kalangan masyarakat setempat dan global.



Para peserta juga telah dibawa melawat ke sekitar muzium yang telah menempatkan pelbagai khazanah naskhah manuskrip yang berharga serta ke lokasi menarik seperti Royale Castle, The Old Town Market Square dan Sasaki Garden. Selain itu, peluang menyertai persidangan ini telah digunakan sebagai landasan berkongsi ilmu tentang kejayaan perkhidmatan perpustakaan universiti terbaik di Asia dan seterusnya menerapkan penemuan dari persidangan dan lawatan ini untuk meningkatkan kualiti perkhidmatan perpustakaan akademik di Malaysia.



PSZ KL Hosted the Library Association Special Interest Group Forum

Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah (PSZ) International Campus recently hosted a forum attended by 30 delegations from other higher learning institutions comprise of their chief librarians and other representatives. Among the Chief Librarians are from USM, UIAM, UNIMAS and UMK. The forum was held at PSZ Seminar Room 2 on 10th May 2011. The delegations were greeted with warmth welcome by PSZ's Chief Librarian, Puan Kamariah Nor Mohd Desa and her staff.

The main issue discussed in the forum was the importance of the establishment of standard performance indicators for academic libraries in Malaysia within the framework provided by the British Standard BS ISO 11620 (Information and documentation- Library Performance Indicators). A paper on PSZ practices was presented by PSZ Chief Librarian Puan Kamariah Nor Mohd Desa, the Deputy Chief Librarian (Development) Encik Anuar Talib and the Deputy Chief Librarian (Services) Puan Noraziah Sharuddin.

Since 2005, numerous forums of cooperation between Malaysian Universities Libraries (PERPUN) have been organized and have resulted in the initiations of various kinds of projects which had benefited Malaysian students and scholars. Among those projects are Malaysian Theses Online (MyTO), e-Repository, Malaysian Gateway Internet Resources, Union List of Serials IPTA/IPTS (MyULIS), etc. Those forums are highly important platforms for those in the library circle to discuss fundamental issues pertaining to the library.
