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UTM-IR Reached another Milestone

UTM Institutional Repository (UTM-IR) has reached another milestone by being in the top 50 Institutional Repositories, according to the latest analysis by Ranking Web of World Repositories. The July 2011 analysis shows UTM-IR took 37th place for Top Institutional Repositories, while 46th place in Top Repositories category. This is, by far, the best achievement for UTM-IR since its establishment in 2007. Consequently, the ranking analysis, which is published biannually in January and July, has helped to catapult UTM placing in Webometrics Ranking of World Universities.

UTM-IR is developed as part of the Library's effort in capturing, managing and organising collections of digital content generated by faculty, staff and students of UTM. This includes research or seminar papers, part of theses, book chapter and journal articles published by the UTM community. Even though most of the content in UTM-IR are being managed by the Library, UTM-IR also allows self-archiving in which the appointed members of the faculty can deposit copies of their papers. In return, these collections are made accessible whenever and wherever via online.

Mempromosi Jenama UTM Melalui UTMRS

UTM Reading Stations (UTMRS) yang telah dilancarkan pada 4 Mei 2009, kini meluaskan lagi sayapnya melalui penubuhan UTMRS di SMK Mutiara Rini, SMK Skudai, SK Taman Universiti 4, SK Taman Sri Pulai, Jabatan Pelajaran Negeri Johor, Bahagian Teknologi Pendidikan Negeri Johor dan juga di Lapangan Terbang Antarabangsa Senai sebagai sebahagian daripada UTM Faces. Penubuhan UTMRS ini merupakan usaha Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah dalam memupuk persekitaran ditandakan ilmu, dan pada masa yang sama mempromosi jenama UTM sebagai universiti yang menyokong usaha meningkatkan taraf literasi dan budaya membaca dalam kalangan komuniti.

UTMRS berkonsepkan terbuka dimana sesiapa sahaja boleh membaca, meminjam dan memulangkan bahan bacaan pada bila-bila masa dan dimana-mana UTMRS. Apa yang menarik, koleksi bahan-bahan bacaan di UTMRS adalah hasil daripada sumbangan masyarakat UTM serta komuniti sekitarnya. Sumbangan seperti buku, majalah dan pelbagai bahan bacaan lain dibuat melalui kotak khas yang terdapat di sekitar kampus UTM atau UTMRS. Kaedah ini terbukti berjaya apabila sebanyak **24,107** bahan bacaan telah dikumpulkan dan ditempatkan di UTMRS sejak mula diperkenalkan pada tahun 2009. Kini, bilangan UTMRS dalam kampus Johor Bahru adalah sebanyak 49 buah manakala di Kuala Lumpur adalah 13 buah.

Uncovering the Secrets of Database Search Strategy

This short guide will provide you with a simple strategy that you can apply to most databases (and many search engines) you will encounter.


- Selecting a Database** - Some databases are subject specific, while others contain information on many topics or famously known as multidisciplinary databases. Select a database that is appropriate for your topic (refer to our website for List of Databases by Faculty) or browse the list of databases (select from the A-Z Listing).
- Determining your Keywords** - Before you can start searching for articles on any database you need to identify the keywords you are going to use as search terms. Keywords or search terms describe the main concepts or ideas in your topic.

Topic: How does violence in the media affect children?

Keywords: violence, media, children

- Searching Strategies** - One of the basic techniques for searching is using the Boolean Operators. Boolean searching is a symbolic logic system that creates relationships between concepts and words. The basic Boolean Operators are **AND**, **OR**, **NOT**.

The AND operator



violence **AND** media

Use **AND** to narrow a search strategy and to look for two or more terms in your result


The OR operator



violence **OR** crime

Use **OR** to broaden a search and to find either or both concepts in the result.

The NOT operator



violence **NOT** war

Use **NOT** before a term to exclude it from your result.

1 In the search box, type the name of the subject (e.g Basic Electrical Engineering) OR the code (e.g SAB 2112).

2 Select **Search Resource** -> **UTM Examination Paper**

3 Click **Search**

4 An Item Details or Result Lists will be displayed. Click **Full Text** to view the examination paper.

5 The examination paper is displayed in CyberDOCS. Now you can either print or save the examination paper for your use.



Program 5S ini merupakan satu amalan pengurusan yang teratur yang berasal dari Jepun, dan melibatkan 5 komponen utama iaitu Silih, Susun, Sapu, Seragam dan Sentiasa Amat. Melalui program 5S, kualiti perkhidmatan dan penyampaianya dapat dipertingkatkan melalui persekitaran kerja yang kondusif, setesa dan selamat.

Sekitar Julai 2011, PSZ telah memulakan kembali program 5S melalui satu sesi taklimat 'Perlaksanaan Program 5S' yang disampaikan oleh Puan Norazlina Md. PSZ ICKL Visit to Putrajaya

A group of 23 people consisting of 20 staff from PSZ International Campus Kuala Lumpur (PSZ ICKL) staff and 3 practical students from UTM visited Putrajaya Wetland and Museum of Nature in Putrajaya on 26 July 2011. The Putrajaya Wetland is located at Presint 13 whereas Museum of Nature is at Presint 15.

"Man and nature, side by side" is the best phrase to describe Putrajaya Wetlands which is the first and the largest constructed freshwater wetland in the world. It was informed that the wetland has the ability to filter nutrients from inflowing waters which represent the base of many food chains that not only start and finish within the wetland but extend beyond the wetland complex itself. In fact, wetland is best known as habitats for fish and water birds.

The group also took a leisurely cruise at the lake to see many landmarks and views through unique perspectives from the waterway.

Meanwhile, at the Museum of Nature, the group was briefed on Malaysia's natural heritage such as plants, animals, rocks, minerals and fossils. The guided tour fascinated the staff especially at the insect section where they have a number of old fashioned display cabinets containing labeled bugs collection.

In short, the trip to Putrajaya has enabled the group to gain and enjoy a new experience.
