Efforts to monitor the overall performance of academic libraries are an important agenda that must not be overlooked by any educational institution. Therefore, the Library Performance Indicators are introduced to specify the requirements of a performance indicator for libraries, and establish a set of performance indicators to be used by libraries of all types. It also provides guidance on how to implement performance indicators in libraries where such performance indicators were not already in use.

Thus, a three-day conference - '1st PERPUN International Conference and Workshop on Key Performance Indicators for Libraries' - was held from 17th to 19th October 2011, at the Dewan Sultan Iskandar, Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, Johor Bahru. It was jointly organised by the Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah and Conferences of University Libraries and National Library of Malaysia (PERPUN). *turn to page 3*

Blog kadangkala disebut jurnal online, berita online atau diari online. Blog mudah dikemaskini tanpa memerlukan pengaturcaraan dan membolehkan pembaca memberikan komen dan ulasan. Menurut Weil (2006), blog adalah "a frequent, chronological publication of personal thoughts and web links". Blog turut dikategorikan mengikut tajuk tertentu seperti blog isu semasa, blog keagamaan, blog masakan, blog diari, blog automotif, blog teknologi, dan sebagainya. Blogger pula ialah seorang pengendali blog yang juga merupakan penulis, penerbit & pengurus sesebuah blog. Manakala blogging ialah apa saja aktiviti yang dilakukan oleh pengendali blog atau blogger ke atas blog atau blogosphere (komuniti blog).

Adakah Blog menghasilkan pulangan? Ya, meletakkan iklan dalam blog sememangnya cara paling mudah untuk menghasilkan wang. Walau bagaimanapun iklan perlu relevan dengan kandungan blog. Contoh perkhidmatan iklan yang membayar komisen di blog kita adalah seperti Google AdSense, BlogAds dan NuffNang. Jika anda seorang penceramah motivasi, blog boleh dijadikan ruang untuk mempromosikan sesi motivasi, bengkel ataupun menjual buku anda secara online. Contoh blogger jutawan yang menggunakan konsep ini adalah <http://www.irfankhairi.com/>

Jika anda orang biasa seperti saya, maka bolehlah cuba-cuba menjual produk anda sendiri seperti baju, kasut, buku atau e-book, blog, domain hosting, masakan, perhiasan dan sebagainya. Manakala, jika tujuan anda bukan untuk wang ringgit maka, memadailah dengan hanya berkongsi idea, pengalaman dan nasihat anda di blog. "Sharing is caring" dan mungkin ini boleh menjadi saham tambahan anda di akhirat kelak.

Blog yang beretika perlu menyampaikan kebenaran, bersikap berterus terang, menampilkan diri anda yang sebenarnya, bersedia menerima dan menjawab kritikan, tidak kerap menukar alamat blog atau URL, kawal dan pastikan 'mood' anda ketika menulis blog dan peka terhadap undang-undang.

The conference with the theme "Embedding KPI Strategies: Transforming Libraries toward Excellence" provided a forum for information professionals to exchange views and expertise on various topics such as "KPI and Leadership" and "KPI: Transforming Libraries toward Excellence". Among the speakers were Dr. Hajjah Zahrah Mokhtar (UiTM), Ngian Lek Choh (Singapore National Library Board), Professor Dr. Azlan Abdul Rahman (UTM), Lee Cheng Ean (National University of Singapore), Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) Chief Librarian, Amir Hussain Md. Ishak and UTM Chief Librarian, Kamariah Nor Mohd. Desa. The conference, which was officiated by Datin Dr. Zainah Mokhtar also invited Datuk Farida Mohd. Ali, Deputy-Director General of Public Service (Development) to deliver the keynote address.



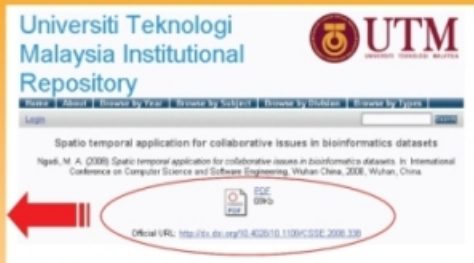
Meanwhile, a workshop focused on the topic "Implementing BS ISO 11620:2008 as Key Performance Indicators in an Organisation" was held on the second day. The workshop session was conducted by Ms. Barbara Lison, the Director of Public Library of Bremen Germany. During the session, Ms. Lison presented the elements of BS ISO 11620:2008, followed by an interactive discussion session with the audience. The focal point of the discussion was identifying suitable performance indicators to be implemented by libraries across discipline which could benefit the customer as well as the organisation.

Accessing Online Resources with DOI

A DOI (Digital object identifier) can be used to cite and link to electronic documents. A DOI is guaranteed never to change, so you can use it to link permanently to electronic documents.

When using UTM Institutional Repository (<http://eprints.utm.my>), you might come across some records which include the DOI link as the official URL. This link will enable user to view the full text at the actual web page. Below is one example.

In some instances, you might find DOIs being included in citations. So, if you have a DOI but you don't know how to get to the article to which it is connected, do the following:

- 1 Go to Resolve a DOI (<http://dx.doi.org>)
- 2 Place the DOI (for example: 10.4028/10.1109/CSSE.2008.338) in the search form.
- 3 If there's no typo in the DOI, this action should lead you to the article.



However, if you are off campus, you may not have access to the article because it's not possible to authenticate people affiliated with UTM through the DOI resolver. If you need access to the full text, go to the A-Z Listings or Proquest 360 Search and search by journal title. If UTM doesn't have online access, search for it by title in OPAC to see if we have it in print. If it's not available at all, request the article from our Interlibrary Loan Service.

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How do you locate, select, organise, and evaluate information? What are the available sources and mediums to obtain information? How do you analyse and synthesise information in any form?

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The Library is offering you to enrol in UQP1211: Information Searching Skills course. The course which will run for 14 weeks on every semester provides the opportunities for you to acquire effective library information skills in order to support your studies in UTM, to realise the importance of information needed in a learning environment, to search for information independently as well as for the purpose of lifelong learning.

Classes will be handled by trained Librarians at Information Searching Labs, which are well equipped with PCs and Internet facilities. Each lab can accommodate of approximately 20 students per session. Modules include introduction to the services, collection and facilities of the Library as well as techniques and skills in searching for printed or electronic sources via OPAC/LESTARI, online databases and other electronic resources.

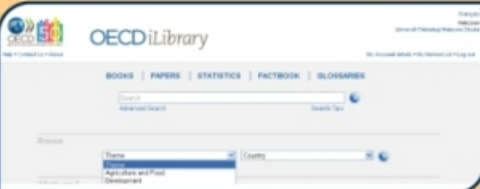

Global Outreach Programme PSZ ke London & Paris

Pasukan Global Outreach Programme (GOP) PSZ yang pertama telah selamat mendarat di Heathrow, London pada 27 Oktober 2011 dengan pesawat MH0004. Lawatan selama seminggu iaitu dari 27 Oktober hingga 4 November 2011 itu telah memberikan pengalaman dan pengetahuan berharga kepada semua 12 peserta GOP. Peserta menginap di rumah penginapan persendirian yang terletak kira-kira 30 minit dari Kota London dengan menaiki keretapi bawah tanah yang dikenali sebagai tube.

Pada hari pertama, kumpulan GOP telah melawat Maughan Library, King's College London. Satu sesi taklimat dan perbincangan telah diadakan bersama-sama Timbalan Pustakawan, Mrs Sally Brock dan Pustakawan, Mr. Graham. Seterusnya, peserta GOP dibawa melawat ke seluruh bahagian Perpustakaan untuk melihat senibina klasik bangunan yang asalnya merupakan Pejabat Rekod milik Keluarga Diraja British. Perpustakaan ini mempunyai sejumlah 1.3 juta koleksi bahan termasuk bahan Koleksi Khas yang telah wujud seawal 1400M. Seramai 25 staf profesional dan 50 staf sokongan bertugas di perpustakaan ini. Menariknya, perpustakaan ini menyediakan perkhidmatan bermula jam 8.00 pagi sehingga jam 6.30 petang dan seterusnya dilanjutkan ke 10.00 malam dengan perkhidmatan layan diri yang diselia oleh pengawal keselamatan Universiti.

Seterusnya kumpulan GOP PSZ mengunjungi University College London yang disambut oleh Pustakawan Mr Scott Foulan. Beliau yang mengendalikan lawatan berpandu, turut memberi penerangan kepada ahli GOP mengenai perkhidmatan perpustakaan yang disediakan. Beliau telah turut membawa peserta ke Perpustakaan Sains Sosial dan Kemanusiaan, Perpustakaan Kejuruteraan serta Muzium Universiti.

Hari ketiga menyaksikan kumpulan GOP melawat ke Universiti Cambridge dengan menaiki keretapi dari Stesen St.Pancras ke Stesen Cambridge. Keindahan semulajadi di Bandar Cambridge sebagai Bandar Universiti sangat memukau. Kedatangan kumpulan kami disambut oleh Mrs Marjolein Allen. Perpustakaan Cambridge yang juga salah satu pusat deposit bahan Kerajaan British mempunyai koleksi sejumlah 8 juta dan susunatur klasik yang sangat mengagumkan.

Seterusnya, seramai 8 orang peserta GOP mengambil peluang untuk melawat Paris dengan menaiki keretapi Eurostar yang memakan masa selama 2 jam 15 minit dari London. Lawatan sehari itu telah memberi peluang peserta melawat tempat-tempat bersejarah di Paris iaitu Sacre Cover, The Champs Elysées, Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame dan menaiki tram melawat sekitar Bandar Paris.

Lawatan akademik seterusnya adalah ke British Library yang merupakan Perpustakaan Negara di United Kingdom. Ia mempunyai sejumlah 150 juta koleksi dari seluruh dunia. Pihak PSZ telah menghadihkan beberapa buah buku terbitan PSZ dan UTM untuk dijadikan koleksi British Library. Kumpulan GOP juga telah mengambil kesempatan untuk melawat ke Muzium British yang mempunyai pelbagai koleksi pameran yang sangat menarik.

Pelbagai pengalaman menarik telah dikutip sepanjang seminggu berada di Kota London. Antaranya cara hidup masyarakatnya yang mengamalkan budi bahasa, menghargai masa, mementingkan kebersihan persekitaran serta menghargai pemeliharaan senibina dan khazanah negara.

Program kali ini mengetengahkan sebuah autobiografi seorang tokoh akademik yang juga merupakan Pro Canselor UTM, iaitu Y.Bhg. Tan Sri Dato' Seri Dr. Saaleh Mohd Nor. Program ini telah dipengerusikan oleh Prof. Alias Mohd. Yusof.

Autobiografi berjudul "Portrait of a Thousand Smiles" yang diterbitkan oleh Akademi Sains Malaysia dengan kerjasama Forest Research Institute Malaysia (FRIM) dan UTM merupakan refleksi kehidupan beliau dari zaman kanak-kanak yang membesar dalam kehidupan kampung di Negeri Sembilan namun berjaya melanjutkan pelajaran ke luar negara sehinggalah mengecapi pelbagai kejayaan hasil dari usaha dan semangat yang tinggi dalam bidang akademik.

Seorang yang berpengetahuan dan mempunyai semangat juang yang tinggi, beliau merupakan antara Saintis Melayu yang pertama dalam bidang perhutanan dan persekitaran. Beliau memiliki Ijazah Sarjana Muda (Perhutanan) dari University of Adelaide dan Diploma dalam bidang yang sama dari Australian Forestry School of Canberra. Seterusnya beliau menyambung pengajian di peringkat Sarjana dan Doktor Falsafah (Phd) di University of Michigan, Amerika Syarikat.

Gaya penyampaian beliau yang bersahaja dan ceria ketika sesi ulasan tersebut telah menarik perhatian para hadirin yang sebahagian besar bilangannya merupakan mahasiswa UTM. Semoga ketokohan dan kesungguhan Tan Sri berkongsi kisah hidupnya melalui program ini dapat memberi inspirasi kepada generasi muda mengenai kepentingan memelihara alam semulajadi untuk persekitaran yang lebih sihat dimasa akan datang.

Co-curriculum class with PSZIC : Starting from 2012, PSZIC in collaboration with Co-Curriculum Centre, UTMIC will introduce a new co-curriculum course for Undergraduate students known as UQP1211: Information Searching Skills. This course will provide hands on training on using library resources systematically and effectively. Students are required to complete 28 credit hours throughout the semester.

RFID Project : In order to improve our services, we are fitting our whole collections with RFID tags in an ongoing project which started on 17 October 2011. So far, a total of 46,670 books were tagged. This projects involves 23 staff and is expected to complete in February 2012.
