You have scoured the whole library looking for one, but to no avail. How about expand your search for digital theses from around the globe?

Here is our choice of links which may be useful for finding digital theses.

✦ **Australasian Digital Theses (ADT)** - <http://adt.caul.edu.au/>



ADT provides full text versions of theses produced by the postgraduate research students at Australian universities. The theses will be available worldwide via the web. The ideal behind the programme is to improve access to, and enhance transfer of, the research information contained in theses.

✦ **Index to Theses** - <http://www.theses.com>



A comprehensive listing of theses with abstracts accepted for higher degrees by universities in Great Britain and Ireland since 1716. Unlike ADT, Index to Theses features thesis abstracts only. However this site provides links to the origin of the sources.

✦ **UTM Institutional Repository (UTM-IR)** - <http://eprints.utm.my>



UTM-IR is a digital collection of the University's intellectual or research output. Among UTM-IR collections are theses by PhD and Masters graduate which are available in full text. To date, about 1,500 records are available.

✦ **ProQuest Digital Dissertation and Theses**



This site contains the world's most comprehensive collection of dissertations and theses which include 2.7 million searchable citations to dissertation and theses from around the world from 1861 to the present day together with 1.2 million full text dissertations that are available for download in PDF format. The database offers full text for most of the dissertations added since 1997 and strong retrospective full text coverage for older graduate works.

The Quest for Research University Status

Ministry of Higher Education (MOHE) accords Research University (RU) status to few selected public university as an acknowledgment to research and teaching activity based on research and development (R&D). One of the perks of such a designation is an additional budget for each university to conduct more research, development and commercialisation activities.

With the acknowledgment as an RU, UTM will have a higher potential to become the front liner in innovation, design and research outputs of international standards. One of the evaluation criteria to be appointed with the status of RU is the quality and quantity of research. Therefore, PSZ together with RMC play an active role in searching, collecting, managing and organising all research publications from the year 2005 to 2009. Each publication is documented, labelled and organised for easy retrieval. These mammoth tasks were carried out with the help from all PSZ staff who have worked all around the clock from weekdays till weekends. The tasks would not be completed without teamwork and sacrifice from everyone. Good job to all!



Where Can I Find Past Years Examination Papers?

With the final examination looming near, many of you would search for past year examination paper for your revision. Let us share with you some tips on how you can search and download them from INFOLAN2.

1. Choose *Internet Explorer* as your Internet browser.
2. Go to the library catalogue (INFOLAN2) from our website (<http://www.psz.utm.my/psz>) and click on UTM Examination Papers.
3. Use *Keyword Search* if you are unsure of the complete name for the subject. Browse Searching can be used to browse for the name of the subject (i.e organic chemistry) in Title or subject code (i.e SSK 2613) in LC Class. Click Submit Search.
4. A *Result List* will be displayed. Click on the subject that you wish to view.
5. A bibliographic record for the examination paper will appear. Click on *Full text* to view the paper.
6. The examination paper will be displayed in CyberDOCS. Now, you can either print or save the examination paper for your use.



PSZ telah menganjurkan tiga siri program K-Culture bagi meneruskan usaha menanam sikap membudayakan ilmu di kalangan warga kampus melalui Program Bicara Karya dan Program Syarahan Ilmu.

Program Bicara Karya Siri 1/2010 : Berpaksi Inovasi Mengangkasa Universiti, Menjana Nilai Tinggi

Program Bicara Karya Siri 1/2010 telah dijalankan pada 27 dan 28 Januari 2010 bertempat di Dewan Jumaah, UTM International Campus dan Dewan Senat, UTM Skudai. Siri pertama bagi tahun 2010 ini telah membincangkan mengenai buku hasil nukilan Y.Bhg. Prof. Dato' Ir. Dr. Zaini Ujang, Naib Canselor berjudul "Berpaksi Inovasi, Mengangkasa Universiti, Menjana Nilai Tinggi" yang juga merupakan Siri Perutusan Tahun Baru Naib Canselor 2010. Program di UTM International Campus telah dipengerusikan oleh Prof. Dr. Hamdani Saidi, manakala di Skudai dipengerusikan oleh Prof. Dr. Ir. Mohd Azraai Kassim. Kandungan buku tersebut telah diulas oleh dua panel jemputan iaitu Prof. Dr. Azlan Abdul Rahman; Pengarah Hal Ehwal Korporat dan Prof. Dr. Shamsudin Hj. Mohd Amin; Pengarah Sekretariat Research University (RU).

Dalam ulasannya, Prof. Dr. Azlan menyatakan bahawa buku ini adalah satu *blueprint* transformasi dan halatuju UTM berdasarkan konsensus pelan strategik. Ia juga satu bentuk 'akad' di antara pimpinan UTM dan staf untuk bersama dalam menjayakan transformasi ke arah kecemerlangan. Memetik catatan beliau, "*People change when they have DNA - Desire, New Vision and Action Plan*".

Prof. Dr. Shamsudin pula menyentuh tentang ciri-ciri struktur baru UTM dan budaya iaitu sinergi dalam kalawangan warga UTM, terutamanya dari segi percambahan idea, efisien dalam pengurusan dan pentadbiran, mengutamakan pencapaian, memperkayakan kebaikan, memperkecilkan keburukan, penyelesaian masalah bukan penimbul masalah dan proaktif dalam menangani isu.

Seluruh warga UTM turut diseru untuk berganding bahu dalam mengupayakan inovasi dalam pengurusan agar pencapaian organisasi melayakkan UTM menjadi Universiti Penyelidikan Inovatif terulung. Inisiatif khas dari segi kerjasama dengan universiti luar negara turut dirancang pada 2010 bagi memastikan UTM mempunyai daya persaingan sengit atau *competitive edge*.

Di akhir program, perkongsian pandangan serta sesi soal jawab di kalangan hadirin turut dibuka. Antara persoalan yang dilontarkan adalah keterlibatan dan peranan staf akademik, bukan akademik serta mahasiswa dalam lonjakan transformasi UTM.

Bicara Karya bersama Tan Sri Datuk Haji Arshad Ayub


Pada 24 Mac 2010 (Rabu) bertempat di Dewan Senat, UTM Skudai, satu lagi program ilmu iaitu Program Bicara Karya telah dilangsungkan untuk kali kedua pada tahun ini. Program kali ini dipengerusikan oleh Tan Sri Abdul Halim Ali, Pengerusi Lembaga Pengarah UTM dan merupakan anjuran bersama Perpustakaan Sultanah Zanariah dan Majlis Profesor UTM.

Program kali ini menampilkan tetamu istimewa yang merupakan antara tokoh pendidikan yang ulung di Malaysia. Beliau adalah Tan Sri Datuk Haji Arshad Ayub, Pro-Canselor Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM). Beliau telah sudi untuk berkongsi pandangan serta pengalaman beliau melalui ulasan biografinya yang bertajuk *A Second Chance: Life and Mission of Arshad Ayub*.

Biografi *A Second Chance: Life and Mission of Arshad Ayub* yang merupakan hasil garapan Rokiah Talib menceritakan kisah hidup Tan Sri Datuk Haji Arshad Ayub yang bermula daripada zaman kanak-kanaknya di Parit Keroma Laut, Muar, sehinggalah beliau dilantik sebagai Pengarah, Institut Teknologi Mara (kini UiTM).

Dalam penyampaian beliau, Tan Sri Datuk Haji Arshad Ayub turut berkongsi kisah-kisah disebalik penubuhan UiTM serta kejayaan UiTM dalam menempa nama sebagai universiti yang berjaya membawa pelajar-pelajar bumiputera keluar dari kelompok kemiskinan.

Era kepimpinan beliau dikenali sebagai '**Era Penerapan**' atas kejayaan beliau menerapkan ciri-ciri kecintaan kepada agama, bangsa dan Negara kepada seluruh warga UTM. Episod perjuangan beliau yang dikupas satu-persatu membawa para hadirin menyelusuri langkah-langkah Tan Sri Dato' Ainnuddin Abdul Wahid dalam memperjuangkan pembangunan dunia pendidikan teknikal dan kejuruteraan. The objectives of the visit were to give the lowdown to the students of how a public library operates and the crucial roles it plays in promoting reading culture and the love for knowledge amongst the community. Upon arrival students were briefed on the collection and services provided by the Library and the highlight of the visit was to try first hand the educational-related tools and interactive exhibitions at the Library's Petronas Playsmart.

After the briefing session, led by the friendly staff, the students were brought to Level 1 and Level 2 where all the collection was located. To their delights all students were given free Library memberships which entitled them to use the Library facilities as well as utilise the collection in the future.

Besides the scheduled visit to the various libraries in the country, the class offers student exposure to the various techniques in searching for information which they can apply anytime, anywhere throughout their life.
